WPAOG's Associate Membership category provides a means for many of these highly valued members of the West Point community to affiliate formally with the Long Gray Line.



Who is eligible for Associate Membership?

- **Former Professors, USMA, and Academy Professors.**
The WPAOG President & CEO offers membership to these individuals, who need only submit a written request for membership to the Association.
- **Military and civilian personnel assigned at West Point with principal duties instructing, training, counseling or coaching cadets.**

What are the benefits of becoming an Associate Member?

The primary benefit is formal association with the Long Gray Line—the graduates of West Point. Additionally, *Associate Members* are informed about WPAOG events and cadets' activities at West Point and around the world, and they receive a certificate for display, as well as a lapel pin and a one-year subscription to *West Point* magazine.

How does one apply for Associate Membership?

Submit the form on the reverse of this brochure. Attach a resume or curriculum vitae. Please feel free to note any volunteer, recreational, or social activities related to West Point. Submit the application packet to WPAOG's Office of Alumni Support, as indicated on the reverse side of this form.

A one-time \$100 initiation fee is due upon approval of the membership.

Administration of the program:

Application packets are reviewed by the Alumni Support Committee, which makes a recommendation on approval to the Board of Directors. The Board, the approval authority, then votes on the application. Both groups apply these guidelines: *Associate Members* support the mission, goals, and ideals of the United States Military Academy and have lived their lives in a manner consistent with the best interests of West Point.
